POSTAGE STAMP COMMEMORATING THE
SECOND AFRO-ASIAN HOUSING CONGRESS IN SINGAPORE.

The Deputy Prime Minister's Office announced today that in connection with the 2nd Afro-Asian Housing Congress which will be held in Singapore from 11th to 19th March 1967, three commemorative postage stamps will be placed on sale at all post offices in the Republic on 11th March 1967. They will be on sale for three months or until stocks are exhausted.

The commemorative issue consists of 10 cents, 25 cents and 50 cents with different background colours. All the three denominations feature a common design of building blocks against a background map of Afro-Asia.

Those who wish to make application for large quantities of these stamps and call for them at the General Post Office, Singapore on the date of release should now write to the Postmaster-General, Singapore. Applicants should provide a self-addressed envelope showing on the outside the number of stamps required and total value. Payment for such advance order should be made on delivery at the General Post Office, Singapore on 11th March, 1967.

Official First Day Covers at 10 cents each will also be placed on sale at all post offices on 11th February. As only a limited number of envelopes will be on sale members of the public are requested to make their purchase early to avoid disappointment.
